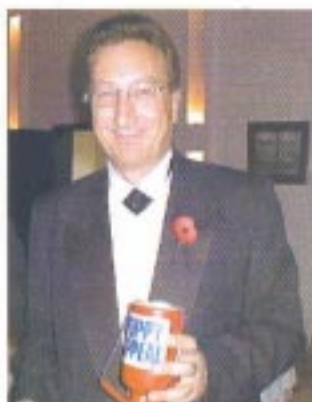
From the world of rugby union, we brought in Bob Norster, ex-Cardiff, Wales, British Lion and Barbarian.
