After the tremendous success of our last visit, I have managed to exclusively secure the Theme Park "FANTASY LAND" situated on the Thumamah Road for a Friday morning in March (Date to be confirmed soon). The gates will open at the park at 0900 to 1200 hours and will be exclusive for RGBB expatriates and their families - ladies will not need an abaya during this time.

However, after 12:00 the general public will gain entry and an abaya will be required again. The cost, payable upon entry, will be SAR 50 per person (children under 4 go free) and will cover the cost of access to the facility and; 4 to 10 year olds – 11 rides; 10 to 16 year olds – 6 rides; plus a seat at the 50-minute Dolphin show at their new Aquarium.

There are many different games and rides including bouncy castles, Water Pedalo's, trampolines etc etc Note: A 10-minute time duration on the quad bikes, six wheelers, go-karts etc. The horse riding and camel rides are not included in the price and have to be paid to the staff on duty at the ride as an outside contractor provides these activities.

This will be a great time for kids of all ages as there are lots of grassed areas and pathways so bring your bicycles or skates and a football.

Food outlets are easily accessible for those who may get hungry through the morning, alternatively you may wish to pack a lunch hamper and eat under the shade of one of the Palm Tress near one of the grassed areas.
