



The Multinational School Overview

The Multinational School opened in September 1998 and is a non-profit organisation managed by a Board of Governors.

The school has adopted the Australian Curriculum Standard Framework (CSF) and has a partnership agreement with Education Victoria. This is an accredited and internationally recognised curriculum.

The CSF ensures an integrated, holistic approach to learning that is comprehensive across all eight learning areas:

- The Arts
- English
- Health and Physical Education
- Mathematics
- Studies of Society and Environment
- Languages other than English
- Science
- Technology

From September 2004, our school implemented the Cambridge International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE). The IGCSE is internationally recognised as being equivalent in standard to the British GCSE and International GCE 'O Level' examinations.

The IGCSE program is a suite of qualifications that provides a broad curriculum suitable for schools and colleges around the world. This programme is designed to encourage high academic standards



through a practical approach to teaching and learning.

Our school offers classes from Pre-Kindergarten to Year Ten. The school is housed in one bright, airy, three storied modern building and sports two

LANGUAGES OTHER THAN ENGLISH
