The Women's Corona Society was formed in 1950 as a voluntary society open to women of all countries which had sympathy with its aims. The name Corona, meaning a crown, was used to indicate its original connections with H.M Overseas Services.

Corona Worldwide is a voluntary non-political ladies group that exists to promote knowledge and understanding of people of different cultures of the world. This is reflected in its emblem, linked hands

symbolising friendship, arranged in a "corona" to emphasis its global spread.

Over the past 50 years its has developed a valuable network of members, branches and contacts in well over 20 different countries in the world as well as very active branches in 24 different counties in the United Kingdom. Corona's head office is in London and we are a U.K registered Charity.

The Riyadh branch of Corona has over 130 members and goes from strength to strength. We meet once a month, on the third Sunday of the month, at the British Embassy from 9.20-11.30 am. We have speakers on a wide variety of topics from Japanese Calligraphy by Tomoko Ono to Mohammed Babelli who delighted everyone with his new book on Saudi Arabia. We have a monthly raffle, an information table and refreshments.

Corona has an annual Ball at the beginning of May which is its main fund raising event of the year, as well as a couple of outings during the year; past trips have been to the Almarai farm and to a plastics factory in the industrial city. At the AGM in February of each year the members vote on which nominated Charities to support.
