The British School Riyadh has over 1000 pupils aged from four to fourteen. We live in a purpose-built, spacious building just off exit 9 next to the Al Hamra Compound. Sixty per cent of our pupils are British passport holders and we do have a certain number of places for other nationalities. The School broadly follows the English National Curriculum and enables students to sit entrance exams for whichever school they go to after leaving Riyadh.

Class sizes are all around twenty right across the school. Over fifty per cent of our teaching staff of eighty are recruited directly from the UK and there are around forty other non-teaching adults.

We have a superb indoor swimming pool and large sports hall, plus a gymnasium and a well-stocked library, as well as separate well-equipped areas for specialist subjects such as Music, Art, Information and Communication Technology, Design Technology and Science. We also provide opportunities for a wide range of extra-curricular activities.
