



BRITISH CONSULAR SERVICES IN SAUDI ARABIA

WHO ARE WE AND WHAT DO WE DO?

We have recently reviewed the way in which the British Embassy in Riyadh, the British Trade Office in Al-Khobar and the British Consulate in Jeddah provide consular services to British Nationals in Saudi Arabia. As a result of this review a dedicated consular team has been set up to cover the whole of Saudi Arabia. Heading this team is HM Consul, Brian Hefford and the Vice Consul Melanie Smart. In each post (Jeddah, Al Khobar and Riyadh) there is a Pro-consul and consular support staff. The Pro-Consul is a locally employed officer who is accredited to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs as a designated signatory for the British Embassy. Our 3 pro-consuls, all of whom speak Arabic, are experienced consular officers with a wealth of local knowledge of Saudi Arabia.
